CORE

1. Computerized physician order entry (CPOE) >30%
2. E-Prescribing (eRx) >40%
3. Report ambulatory clinical quality measures to CMS/States
4. Implement one clinical decision support rule (**at least 1**)
5. Provide patients with an electronic copy of their health information, upon request >50%
6. Provide clinical summaries for patients for each office visit >50%
7. Drug-drug and drug-allergy interaction checks
8. Record demographics >50%
9. Maintain an up-to-date problem list of current and active diagnoses >80%
10. Maintain active medication list >80%
11. Maintain active medication allergy list >80%
12. Record and chart changes in vital signs >50%
13. Record smoking status for patients 13 years or older >50%
14. Capability to exchange key clinical information among providers of care and patient-authorized entities electronically
15. Protect electronic health information

16. Drug-formulary checks
17. Incorporate clinical lab test results as structured data >40%
18. Generate lists of patients by specific conditions (**at least 1**)
19. Send reminders to patients per patient preference for preventive/follow up care >20%
